

SAR NET SCRIPT

Revised: November 19, 2015

Good evening to the stations listening and welcome to the Surrey Amateur Radio Club weekly two meter net. This is (callsign), my name is (name) and I will be your net control this evening. For the duration of the net I will use the club callsign of Victor Echo Seven Sierra Alpha Romeo.

This net operates on the Surrey Amateur Radio Club VHF repeater at a frequency of 147.360 MHz with a tone of 110.9 Hz.

Both IRLP and Echolink are available on this frequency, and instructions on their use can be found on the Surrey Club website at www.ve7sar.net.

We encourage check-ins from Surrey Club members and any other licensed radio amateurs who may be listening. The purpose of the net is to share information on amateur radio events within the Lower Mainland of British Columbia and to keep in touch with each other.

We will begin to-night's net by asking for any news or information on any sick or injured amateurs, come now please.

Secondly we request a report from the Surrey Club Executive. Come now please.

This is Victor Echo Seven Sierra Alpha Romeo. Are there any members of other clubs in the Lower Mainland available with announcements of club events or other items of interest? Come now please.

Are there any questions on tonights reports? Come now please.

We will now move to the check-in portion of tonight's net, which will be followed by a round-table session. Please speak slowly and use phonetics when identifying yourself. Check in with your call sign, name and location.

Are there any Echolink check-ins?, please come now.

(please check for multiple Echolink check ins as we can have unlimited E check-ins at one time before you move on)

I will take check-ins from hand-held stations only, hand-held stations come now, in groups of 3 please.

Next I will take check-ins from mobile stations only in groups of three, come now please

Finally I will take check-ins from base stations only in groups of 3 come now please.

Are there any final announcements for to-night's net? If so come now please.

Any last minute check ins before we start the round table? If anyone has an item for sale or a wanted please have your information ready and announce your item when you are called for the round table.

ROUNDTABLE: Call each check-in in order on the list once. Go around a second time if the Round Table is active, stop to check for anyone wanting to join the Round Table often. Announce at your discretion, a break in the Round Table to close the net, Announce “the Round Table will continue once the net is over please stand by”

Last call for late or missed check-ins this evening. Any relays please? The Surrey Amateur Radio Club holds an informal breakfast meet at the Kalmar Restaurant, Saturday morning at 9:00 am.

We have had a total of ____ check- ins for this evening's net.
